- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing

- Sec. 21-5c. Alternative route to teacher certification. 7
- 8 The State Board of Education, in consultation with the State
- Teacher Certification Board, shall establish and implement an 9
- alternative route to teacher certification program under 10
