2 Any male United States citizen or immigrant who applies for any permit or license authorized to be issued 3 4 under this Act or for a renewal of any permit or license, and 5 who is at least 18 years of age but less than 26 years of age, must be registered in compliance with the requirements 6 7 of the federal Military Selective Service Act. The Secretary of State must forward in an electronic format the necessary 8 9 personal information regarding the applicants identified in this subsection (d) to the Selective Service System. The 10 11 applicant's signature on the application serves as an indication that the applicant either has already registered 12 with the Selective Service System or that he is authorizing 13 the Secretary to forward to the Selective Service System the 14 necessary information for registration. The Secretary must 15 16 notify the applicant at the time of application that his signature constitutes consent to registration with the 17 Selective Service System, if he is not already registered. 18

(e) In addition to the fees collected under Section 6-118 of this Act, the Secretary of State shall ask each person applying for or renewing a license or instruction permit whether the person wishes to make a \$1 voluntary contribution to the Blindness Prevention Fund established under this Section. All donations collected under this subsection (e) shall be deposited into the Blindness Prevention Fund.

(f) The Blindness Prevention Fund is created as a special fund in the State treasury. All moneys in the Fund shall, subject to appropriation by the General Assembly, be used by the Department of Human Services for grants to provide blindness education, screening, and treatment.
