AN ACT in relation to public aid.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by 5 changing Section 5-1 as follows:

6 (305 ILCS 5/5-1) (from Ch. 23, par. 5-1)

7 Sec. 5-1. Declaration of purpose <u>of Article</u>. It is the 8 purpose of this Article to provide a program of essential 9 medical care and rehabilitative services for persons 10 receiving basic maintenance grants under this Code and for 11 other persons who are unable, because of inadequate 12 resources, to meet their essential medical needs.

Preservation of health, alleviation of sickness, and 13 14 correction of handicapping conditions for persons requiring 15 maintenance support are essential if they are to have an 16 opportunity to become self-supporting or to attain a greater capacity for self-care. For persons who are medically 17 indigent but otherwise able to provide themselves with a 18 livelihood, it is of special importance to maintain their 19 20 incentives for continued independence and preserve their limited resources for ordinary maintenance needs to prevent 21 22 their total or substantial dependency.
