- 1 AN ACT concerning insurers.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 155.39 as follows:
- 6 (215 ILCS 5/155.39 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 155.39. Slave era policies.</u>
- 8 (a) The General Assembly finds and declares all of the
- 9 <u>following:</u>
- 10 <u>(1) Insurance policies from the slavery era have</u>
- 11 <u>been discovered in the archives of several insurance</u>
- 12 <u>companies</u>, <u>documenting</u> <u>insurance</u> <u>coverage</u> <u>for</u>
- 13 <u>slaveholders for damage to or death of their slaves,</u>
- issued by a predecessor insurance firm. These documents
- 15 <u>provide the first evidence of ill-gotten profits from</u>
- 16 slavery, which profits in part capitalized insurers whose
- 17 <u>successors remain in existence today.</u>
- 18 (2) Legislation has been introduced in Congress for
- 19 <u>the past 10 years demanding an inquiry into slavery and</u>
- 20 <u>its continuing legacies.</u>
- 21 (3) The Director of Insurance and the Department of
- 22 <u>Insurance are entitled to seek information from the files</u>
- of insurers licensed and doing business in this State,
- 24 <u>including licensed Illinois subsidiaries of international</u>
- 25 <u>insurance corporations, regarding insurance policies</u>
- 26 <u>issued to slaveholders by predecessor corporations. The</u>
- 27 <u>people of Illinois are entitled to significant historical</u>
- 28 <u>information of this nature.</u>
- 29 <u>(b) The Department shall request and obtain information</u>
- 30 <u>from insurers licensed and doing business in this State</u>
- 31 regarding any records of slaveholder insurance policies

- issued by any predecessor corporation during the slavery era.
- 2 (c) The Department shall obtain the names of any
- 3 slaveholders or slaves described in those insurance records,
- 4 and shall make the information available to the public and
- 5 <u>the General Assembly.</u>
- 6 (d) Any insurer licensed and doing business in this
- 7 State shall research and report to the Department with
- 8 respect to any records within the insurer's possession or
- 9 knowledge relating to insurance policies issued to
- 10 slaveholders that provided coverage for damage to or death of
- 11 <u>their slaves.</u>
- (e) Descendants of slaves, whose ancestors were defined
- 13 <u>as private property, dehumanized, divided from their</u>
- 14 <u>families</u>, <u>forced</u> to <u>perform labor without appropriate</u>
- 15 <u>compensation or benefits, and whose ancestors' owners were</u>
- 16 <u>compensated for damages by insurers, are entitled to full</u>
- 17 <u>disclosure</u>.
