- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing
- 5 Section 27-22.3 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/27-22.3) (from Ch. 122, par. 27-22.3)
- 7 Sec. 27-22.3. Volunteer service credit program.
- 8 (a) A school district may establish a volunteer service
- 9 credit program that enables secondary school students to earn
- 10 credit towards graduation through performance of community
- 11 service. This community service may include participation in
- 12 <u>a high school or community blood drive or other blood donor</u>
- 13 <u>recruitment campaign.</u> Any program so established shall begin
- 14 with students entering grade 9 in the 1993-1994 school year
- 15 or later. The amount of credit given for program
- 16 participation shall not exceed that given for completion of
- 17 one semester of language arts, math, science or social
- 18 studies.
- 19 (b) Any community service performed as part of a course
- 20 for which credit is given towards graduation shall not
- 21 qualify under a volunteer service credit program. Any
- 22 service for which a student is paid shall not qualify under a
- 23 volunteer service credit program. Any community work
