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AN ACT in relation to public aid.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
changing Section 5-1 as follows:

6 (305 ILCS 5/5-1) (from Ch. 23, par. 5-1)

Sec. 5-1. Declaration of purpose. It is the purpose of 7 8 this Article to provide a program of essential medical care and rehabilitative services for persons receiving basic 9 maintenance grants under this Code and for other persons who 10 are unable, because of inadequate resources, to meet their 11 essential medical needs. It is the purpose of this Article to 12 13 provide full funding of the costs of services to meet those essential medical needs. 14

Preservation of health, alleviation of sickness, 15 and 16 correction of handicapping conditions for persons requiring maintenance support are essential if those persons they are 17 18 to have an opportunity to become self-supporting or to attain a greater capacity for self-care. For persons who are 19 20 medically indigent but otherwise able to provide themselves with a livelihood, it is of special importance to maintain 21 22 their incentives for continued independence and preserve their limited resources for ordinary maintenance needs to 23 prevent their total or substantial dependency. 24
