- 1 AN ACT concerning hospitals.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Emergency Medical Services Systems Act is
- 5 amended by adding Section 3.21 as follows:
- 6 (210 ILCS 50/3.21 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 3.21. Hospital first responders. The General</u>
- 8 Assembly finds that in the event of terrorist acts,
- 9 <u>especially those involving the release of biological agents</u>,
- 10 <u>bacteria</u>, <u>viruses</u>, <u>or other agents intended to cause illness</u>
- or injury, hospitals serve as first responders in diagnosing
- 12 and treating the victims of those acts. As first responders,
- 13 <u>hospitals are on the front lines of the State's emergency</u>
- 14 <u>management efforts</u>. Given the increased demands for
- 15 equipment, materials, and training associated with their
- 16 <u>responsibility</u> as first responders in the event of terrorist
- 17 <u>acts, hospitals would benefit from additional resources to</u>
- 18 <u>enable them to be better prepared to protect and aid the</u>
- 19 <u>residents of the State. In awarding funds to support disaster</u>
- 20 <u>preparedness by first responders, the Department and any</u>
- 21 <u>other State agencies shall take into account the role of</u>
- 22 <u>hospitals in being prepared to respond to emergencies or</u>
- disasters.
- 24 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 25 becoming law.
