- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Procurement Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 5-30 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 500/5-30 new)
- Sec. 5-30. Agency procurement policy.
- 8 (a) On a schedule developed by the Board, each agency
- 9 <u>shall</u> <u>submit</u> <u>to the Board its written procurement policies.</u>
- 10 Before changing a procurement policy, a State agency shall
- 11 <u>notify the Board in writing of its changes.</u>
- 12 (b) The Board may require a State agency to respond in
- 13 writing to its inquiries and recommendations regarding
- 14 procurement. The Board may assume the procurement authority
- of a State agency that fails to respond or that responds
- 16 <u>insufficiently</u>. The Board's assumption of authority shall be
- 17 <u>temporary until the dispute is resolved and shall be limited</u>
- 18 to the procurement policy that is the subject of the dispute.
