- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 368d as follows:
- 6 (215 ILCS 5/368d new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 368d. Fairness in contracting procedures.</u>
- 8 <u>(a) A health care professional or health care provider</u>
- 9 shall be provided with a complete copy of any proposed
- 10 professional services contract including access to all
- 11 required or referenced policies, protocols, or procedures.
- 12 The health care professional or health care provider shall be
- 13 <u>allowed at least 30 days to review the complete contract</u>
- 14 <u>before being required to sign the contract.</u>
- 15 (b) A health care professional or health care provider
- 16 <u>shall be provided written notice of any proposed material</u>
- 17 <u>changes to the contract or its administrative policies. The</u>
- 18 professional or provider shall be given the opportunity to
- 19 <u>terminate the contract prior to the effective date of the</u>
- 20 proposed change. At least 90 days notice of any proposed
- 21 <u>change shall be provided.</u>
- 22 Section. 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on
