- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections
- 5 2-3.131 and 2-3.132 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/2-3.131 new)
- 7 Sec. 2-3.131. Teacher signing bonus. Subject to
- 8 appropriation, the State Board of Education shall establish
- 9 <u>and administer a program to provide signing bonuses to</u>
- 10 <u>teachers</u> who contract with the State Board of Education to
- 11 <u>teach in a public school, for a minimum of 5 consecutive</u>
- 12 school years, in a school district that has a shortage of
- 13 <u>teachers or in a subject area that has a shortage of</u>
- 14 <u>teachers. The State Board of Education shall determine the</u>
- 15 <u>amount of the bonus. A teacher who receives a signing bonus</u>
- 16 <u>under this program shall not be deemed an employee of the</u>
- 17 <u>State. The State Board of Education may adopt any rules</u>

- 21 <u>Sec. 2-3.132</u>. <u>Teacher loan repayment program</u>. <u>Subject to</u>
- 22 <u>appropriation</u>, the State Board of Education shall establish
- 23 <u>and administer a loan repayment program for teachers who</u>
- 24 <u>contract with the State Board of Education to teach in a</u>
- 25 <u>public school, for a minimum of 5 consecutive school years,</u>
- 26 <u>in a school district that has a shortage of teachers or in a</u>
- 27 <u>subject area that has a shortage of teachers. Under this</u>
- 28 program, each school year the State Board of Education shall
