- 1 AN ACT concerning wildlife.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Wildlife Code is amended by changing
- 5 Section 2.25 as follows:
- 6 (520 ILCS 5/2.25) (from Ch. 61, par. 2.25)
- 7 Sec. 2.25. It shall be unlawful for any person to take
- 8 deer except (i) with a shotgun or muzzleloading rifle or (ii)
- 9 as provided by administrative rule, with a bow and arrow, or
- 10 crossbow device for handicapped persons as defined in Section
- 11 2.33, during the open season of not more than 14 days which
- 12 will be set annually by the Director between the dates of
- November 1st and December 31st, both inclusive.
- 14 It shall be unlawful for any person to take deer except
- 15 with a bow and arrow, or crossbow device for handicapped
- 16 persons (as defined in Section 2.33), during the open season
- for bow and arrow set annually by the Director between the
- dates of September 1st and January 31st, both inclusive.
- 19 It shall be unlawful for any person to take deer except
- 20 with (i) a muzzleloading rifle, or (ii) bow and arrow, or
- 21 crossbow device for handicapped persons as defined in Section
- 22 2.33, during the open season for muzzleloading rifles set
- annually by the Director.
- 24 The Director shall cause an administrative rule setting
- forth the prescribed rules and regulations, including bag and
- 26 possession limits and those counties of the State where open
- 27 seasons are established, to be published in accordance with
- 28 Sections 1.3 and 1.13 of this Act.
- 29 <u>The Department may establish separate harvest periods for</u>
- 30 the purpose of managing or eradicating disease that has been
- found in the deer herd. This season shall be restricted to

- 1 gun or bow and arrow hunting only. The Department shall
- 2 <u>publicly announce, via statewide news release, the season</u>
- 3 dates and shooting hours, the counties and sites open to
- 4 <u>hunting</u>, <u>permit requirements</u>, <u>application dates</u>, <u>hunting</u>
- 5 rules, legal weapons, and reporting requirements.
- 6 The Department is authorized to establish a separate
- 7 harvest period at specific sites within the State for the
- 8 purpose of harvesting surplus deer that cannot be taken
- 9 during the regular season provided for the taking of deer.
- 10 This season shall be restricted to gun or bow and arrow
- 11 hunting only and shall be established during the period of
- 12 September 1st to February 15th, both inclusive. The
- 13 Department shall publish suitable prescribed rules and
- 14 regulations established by administrative rule pertaining to
- 15 management restrictions applicable to this special harvest
- 16 program.
