- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 12-13.3 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 5/12-13.3 new)
- 7 Sec. 12-13.3. Aid for victims of domestic violence or
- 8 extreme cruelty.
- 9 (a) Subject to appropriations, the Department of Human
- 10 <u>Services shall develop and implement a program to provide</u>
- 11 <u>cash assistance, equivalent to that provided to recipients of</u>
- 12 <u>aid under Article IV of this Code, to persons (i) who are</u>
- 13 <u>legal immigrants to the United States, (ii) who would be</u>
- 14 <u>eligible for aid under Article IV but for the 5-year presence</u>
- requirement under Section 1-11, and (iii) who are either:
- 16 <u>(1) children who have been victims of domestic</u>
- 17 <u>violence or extreme cruelty committed within the United</u>
- 18 <u>States; or</u>
- 19 <u>(2) adults who have been victims of domestic</u>
- 20 <u>violence or extreme cruelty committed within the United</u>
- 21 <u>States, provided that such an adult has not committed the</u>
- 22 <u>domestic violence or extreme cruelty against a child</u>
- described in paragraph (1).
- 24 The Department shall provide aid under this Section as a
- 25 means of assisting the recipients to escape the circumstances
- 26 <u>under which they have been subjected to domestic violence or</u>

- (b) The Department, by rule, may impose a limit on the
- 29 <u>period of time for which a person may receive aid under this</u>
