- 4 Section 5. The Sex Offender Registration Act is amended
- 5 by changing Section 10 as follows:

Sec. 10. Penalty.

- 8 register under this Article who violates any of the 9 provisions of this Article and any person who is required to 10 register under this Article who seeks to change his or her

- 23 <u>local county jail. If the sex offender was convicted of</u>
- 24 aggravated criminal sexual assault on a person, regardless of

- 27 <u>assault on someone under 18 years of age, over 60 years of</u>
- 28 age, mentally challenged, or physically disabled, the minimum
- 29 <u>period of confinement shall be one year. If a weapon was</u>
- 30 <u>used in commission of the offense, all minimum penalties</u>
- 31 <u>prescribed in this Section shall be doubled.</u> The court shall

- 1 impose a mandatory minimum fine of \$500 for failure to comply
- 2 with any provision of this Article. If a sex offender who
- 3 fails to comply with this Article was convicted of aggravated
- 4 <u>criminal sexual assault, the court shall impose a minimum</u>
- 5 fine of \$1,500. If the offense was against a person under 18
- 6 years of age or over 60 years of age, the minimum fine shall
- 7 <u>be \$2,000. If a weapon was used in the commission of the</u>
- 8 offense, the minimum fines imposed under this Section shall
- 9 <u>be doubled.</u> These fines shall be deposited in the Sex
- 10 Offender Registration Fund. Any sex offender, as defined in
- 11 Section 2 of this Act, or sexual predator who violates any
- 12 provision of this Article may be tried in any Illinois county
- where the sex offender can be located.
