- 7 Sec. 11-1010. Pedestrians under influence of alcohol, er
- 8 drugs, or intoxicating compounds.
- 9 <u>(a)</u> A pedestrian who is under the influence of alcohol,
- 10 er any drug, any intoxicating compound, or any combination of
- 11 <u>alcohol</u>, <u>drug</u>, <u>or intoxicating compound</u> to a degree which
- 12 renders himself a hazard shall not walk or be upon a highway
- except on a sidewalk. A violation of this subsection (a) is a
- 14 <u>Class C misdemeanor.</u>
- 15 (b) A person who violates subsection (a) and, as a
- 16 result of the violation, is a proximate cause of an accident
- 17 <u>resulting in great bodily harm or death to any other person</u>
- is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.
