- 1 AN ACT in relation to public aid.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
- 5 changing Section 5-4.1 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 5/5-4.1) (from Ch. 23, par. 5-4.1)
- 7 Sec. 5-4.1. Co-payments. The Department may by rule
- 8 provide that recipients under any Article of this Code <u>must</u>
- 9 shall pay a fee as a co-payment for services. Co-payments
- 10 may not exceed \$3 for brand name drugs, \$1 for other pharmacy
- 11 services, and \$2 for physicians services, dental services,
- 12 optical services and supplies, chiropractic services,
- 13 podiatry services, and encounter rate clinic services.
- 14 Co-payments may not exceed \$3 for hospital outpatient and
- 15 clinic services. Provided, however, that any such rule must
- 16 provide that no co-payment requirement can exist for renal
- 17 dialysis, radiation therapy, cancer chemotherapy, or insulin,
- 18 and other products necessary on a recurring basis, the
- 19 absence of which would be life threatening, or where
- 20 co-payment expenditures for required services and/or
- 21 medications for chronic diseases that the Illinois Department
- 22 shall by rule designate shall cause an extensive financial
- 23 burden on the recipient, and provided no co-payment shall
- 24 exist for emergency room encounters that which are for
- 25 medical emergencies.
