- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 is
- 5 amended by adding Section 108-15 as follows:
- 6 (725 ILCS 5/108-15 new)
- 7 Sec. 108-15. Police dogs; controlled substance and
- 8 <u>cannabis violations.</u>
- 9 (a) In this Section, "police dog" means a dog trained to
- 10 <u>assist peace officers in their law enforcement duties.</u>
- 11 (b) A police dog who is trained in accordance with
- 12 <u>standards prescribed by the Director of State Police in</u>
- 13 consultation with the Illinois Law Enforcement Training
- 14 Standards Board may, consistent with the Fourth and
- 15 Fourteenth Amendments to the United States Constitution and
- 16 Article I, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution, search for
- 17 the presence of cannabis or a controlled substance by
- 18 sniffing persons, vehicles, or other items, and if the
- 19 <u>sniffing indicates to a peace officer the presence of</u>
- 20 <u>cannabis or a controlled substance in violation of the</u>
- 21 <u>Cannabis Control Act or the Illinois Controlled Substances</u>
- 22 Act, such indication constitutes probable cause for a peace
- officer to search the person, vehicle, or other item that the
- 24 police dog sniffed and any cannabis or controlled substances
- 25 <u>seized are admissible into evidence in a criminal</u>
- 26 prosecution.
