- 4 Section 5. The Open Meetings Act is amended by changing
- 5 Section 2.05 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 2.05. Subject to the provisions of "An Act in
- 8 relation to the rights of witnesses at proceedings conducted
- 9 by a court, commission, administrative agency or other

- 11 which motion pictures are taken", approved July 14, 1953, as
- 12 amended, any person may record the proceedings at meetings
- required to be open by this Act by tape, film or other means.
- 14 The authority holding the meeting shall prescribe reasonable

- or sound recordings are made, a copy of the recordings must
- be made available for review by the public.
- 18 If a witness at any meeting required to be open by this
