- 4 Section 5. The Attorney General Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 4f as follows:
- 6 (15 ILCS 205/4f new)
- 7 <u>Sec 4f. Public corruption hotline.</u>
- 8 (a) The Attorney General, as soon as may be practical,
- 9 <u>must establish and maintain a public corruption telephone</u>
- 10 <u>hotline and a web site through which public corruption may be</u>
- 11 reported. Reporters are entitled to strict confidentiality,
- 12 and the Attorney General must not disclose the identity of
- 13 reporters unless compelled to do so by a court because of
- 14 <u>exiqent circumstances</u>.
- (b) Reports of public corruption must be screened by
- 16 <u>Assistant Attorneys General and in appropriate cases referred</u>
- for investigation and possible prosecution to the responsible
