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AN ACT making appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

21 Section 3. The sum of \$185,000, or so much thereof as 22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois 23 Firefighters' Memorial Fund to the Office of the State Fire 24 Marshal for expenses related to the maintenance of the 25 Illinois Firefighters' Memorial, holding the annual Fallen 26 Firefighter and Firefighter Medal of Honor Ceremonies, and 27 other expenses as allowed under Public Act 91-0832.

28 Section 6. The sum of \$550,000, or so much thereof as 29 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground 30 Storage Tank Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for 31 a grant to the City of Chicago for Administrative Costs incurred as a result of the State's Underground Storage
Program.

3 Section 7. The sum of \$2,000, or so much thereof as may 4 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund 5 to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants available 6 for the development of new fire districts.

7 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on8 July 1, 2003.
