AN ACT regarding higher education.

2 Whereas, individual Illinois public universities have 3 discretion to formulate their own specific policies on 4 in-state tuition for military personnel whose state of 5 residence is not Illinois; and

6 Whereas, Illinois public universities have adopted 7 generous policies for soldiers and family members within the 8 state of legal residence and in the state of assignment; and

9 Whereas, these policies currently exclude continuity of 10 in-state tuition for military personnel and their dependents 11 once established; and

Whereas, the General Assembly urges the Board of Trustees of each public university in the State to adopt a policy ensuring that changes in permanent duty station to locations outside of this State shall not affect the rate of tuition that the member or his or her dependent is receiving as long as the person is continuously enrolled at the university; therefore

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:
