(a) Every application for any permit or license authorized
to be issued under this Act shall be made upon a form furnished
by the Secretary of State. Every application shall be
accompanied by the proper fee and payment of such fee shall
entitle the applicant to not more than 3 attempts to pass the
examination within a period of 1 year after the date of
application.

25 (b) Every application shall state the name, social security number, zip code, date of birth, sex, and residence address of 26 27 the applicant; briefly describe the applicant; state whether 28 the applicant has theretofore been licensed as a driver, and, 29 if so, when and by what state or country, and whether any such 30 license has ever been cancelled, suspended, revoked or refused, 31 and, if so, the date and reason for such cancellation, include 32 suspension, revocation or refusal; shall an affirmation by the applicant that all information set forth is 33

The Secretary of State shall 31 provide to the Department of Revenue all information, including 32 33 the individual taxpayer identification number, captured on the application. If the Department of Revenue determines that the 34

licensee is not in compliance with any applicable tax laws 1 administered by the Department of Revenue, the Department of 2 3 Revenue shall request that the Secretary of State suspend or revoke the license. An applicant denied a driver's license 4 5 under this subsection (b-2) may seek review under the Administrative Review Law. This amendatory Act of the 93rd 6 7 General Assembly does not affect the issuance of any commercial driver's license or school bus driver's permit under the 8 Illinois Vehicle Code or any identification card under the 9 10 Illinois Identification Card Act. A drivers license issued under this subsection (b-2) may not be used to obtain a Firearm 11 Owner's Identification Card and may not be used to obtain a 12 driver's license in another state. A driver licensed under this 13 subsection (b-2) shall, within 30 days of receiving a license, 14 provide to the Secretary of State proof of insurance and is 15 subject to the mandatory insurance requirements of this Code. 16
