Amends the Open Meetings Act. Redefines a "public body" subject to the Act to exclude certain drug enforcement task forces. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning public bodies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Open Meetings Act is amended by changing Section 1.02 as follows:
- 6 (5 ILCS 120/1.02) (from Ch. 102, par. 41.02)
- 7 Sec. 1.02. For the purposes of this Act:
- "Meeting" means any gathering of a majority of a quorum of the members of a public body held for the purpose of discussing public business.

"Public body" includes all legislative, executive, 11 administrative or advisory bodies of the State, counties, 12 townships, cities, villages, incorporated towns, 13 school districts and all other municipal corporations, boards, 14 15 bureaus, committees or commissions of this State, and any subsidiary bodies of any of the foregoing including but not 16 17 limited to committees and subcommittees which are supported in whole or in part by tax revenue, or which expend tax revenue, 18 19 except the General Assembly and committees or commissions 20 thereof. "Public body" includes tourism boards and convention or civic center boards located in counties that are contiguous 21 22 to the Mississippi River with populations of more than 250,000 but less than 300,000. "Public body" includes the Health 23 Facilities Planning Board. "Public body" does not include a 24 child death review team or the Illinois Child Death Review 25 Teams Executive Council established under the Child Death 26 Review Team $Act_{\underline{i}}$ or an ethics commission acting under the State 27 28 Officials and Employees Ethics Act; or a metropolitan 29 enforcement group (MEG) established under the Intergovernmental Drug Laws Enforcement Act or a police drug 30 enforcement task force established through an 31

32 intergovernmental agreement.
