AN ACT concerning hate crimes.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Department of State Police Law of the Civil
Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by changing Section
2605-390 as follows:

8 Sec. 2605-390. Hate crimes.

(a) To collect and disseminate information relating to 9 "hate crimes" as defined under Section 12-7.1 of the Criminal 10 Code of 1961 contingent upon the availability of State or 11 federal funds to revise and upgrade the Illinois Uniform Crime 12 Reporting System. All law enforcement agencies shall report 13 14 monthly to the Department concerning those offenses in the form 15 and in the manner prescribed by rules and regulations adopted by the Department. The information shall be compiled by the 16 17 Department and be disseminated upon request to any local law enforcement agency, unit of local government, or State agency. 18 19 Dissemination of the information shall be subject to all 20 confidentiality requirements otherwise imposed by law.

(b) The Department shall provide training for State Police officers in identifying, responding to, and reporting all hate crimes. The Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board shall develop and certify a course of such training to be made available to local law enforcement officers.
