Additional fees to finance court system. county board may enact by ordinance or resolution the following 8 9 fees: (a) A \$5 fee to be paid by the defendant on a judgment of 10 guilty or a grant of supervision for violation of the Illinois 11 Vehicle Code other than Section 11-501 or violations of similar 12 provisions contained in county or municipal ordinances 13 14 committed in the county, and up to a \$30 fee to be paid by the defendant on a judgment of guilty or a grant of supervision for 15 16 violation of Section 11-501 of the Illinois Vehicle Code or a 17 violation of a similar provision contained in county or 18 municipal ordinances committed in the county. (b) In the case of a county having a population of 19 1,000,000 or less, a \$5 fee to be collected in all civil cases 20 21 by the clerk of the circuit court. (c) A fee to be paid by the defendant on a judgment of 22

guilty or a grant of supervision under Section 5-9-1 of the

Unified Code of Corrections, as follows:

- 1 (1) for a felony, \$50;
- 2 (2) for a class A misdemeanor, \$25;
- 3 (3) for a class B or class C misdemeanor, \$15;
- 4 (4) for a petty offense, \$10;
- 5 (5) for a business offense, \$10.
 - (d) A \$100 fee for the second and subsequent violations of Section 11-501 of the Illinois Vehicle Code or violations of similar provisions contained in county or municipal ordinances committed in the county. The proceeds of this fee shall be placed in the county general fund and used to finance education programs related to driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
 - (d-5) A \$10 fee to be paid by the defendant on a judgment of guilty or a grant of supervision under Section 5-9-1 of the Unified Code of Corrections to be placed in the county general fund and used to finance the county mental health court.
- (e) The proceeds of all fees enacted under this Section shall, except as provided in <u>subsections</u> subsection (d) <u>and</u> (d-5), be placed in the county general fund and used to finance the court system in the county, unless the fee is subject to disbursement by the circuit clerk as provided under Section 27.5 of the Clerks of Courts Act.
