Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that qualified applicants pay no additional original issuance fee for Bronze Star and Silver Star special license plates.

1 AN ACT concerning vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing 5 Sections 3-628 and 3-642 as follows:
- (625 ILCS 5/3-628) 6
- 7 Sec. 3-628. Bronze Star plates.
- (a) Beginning January 1, 1996, in addition to any other special license plate, the Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may issue special registration plates to residents of Illinois who have been awarded the Bronze Star by the United States Armed Forces. The special plate issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles 15 of the first division, motorcycles, or motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this Section shall expire according to the staggered multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 19 of this Code.
 - (b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe the eligibility requirements and, in his or her discretion, shall approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided under Section 3-412.
- (c) (Blank). An applicant shall be charged a \$15 fee for 30 original issuance in addition to the appropriate registration 31 32 fee.

- 5 Sec. 3-642. Silver Star plates.
- (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and 6 7 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may issue special registration plates to residents of Illinois who 8 have been awarded the Silver Star by the United States Armed 9 10 Forces. The special plate issued under this Section shall be 11 affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, 12 motorcycles, or motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this Section 13 14 shall expire according to the staggered multi-year procedure 15 established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.
 - (b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe the eligibility requirements and, in his or her discretion, shall approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided under Section 3-412.
 - (c) (Blank). An applicant shall be charged a \$15 fee for original issuance in addition to the appropriate registration fee.
