An affidavit that no action at law for damages arising out of the motor vehicle accident has been filed against the applicant, or if filed that it is not still pending shall be prima facie evidence of that fact. The Secretary of State may take whatever steps are necessary to verify the statement set forth in the applicant's affidavit.

(b) The driver's license or registration and nonresident's 12 13 operating privileges suspended as provided in Section 7-205 shall also remain suspended and shall not be renewed nor shall 14 15 any license or registration be issued to the person until the person gives proof of his or her financial responsibility in 16 the future as provided in Section 1-164.5. The proof is to be 17 18 maintained by the person in a manner satisfactory to the Secretary of State for a period of 3 years after the date the 19 proof is first filed. 20
