Amends the Detection of Deception Examiners Act. Makes technical changes to a Section concerning the use of an instrument to record the subject's cardiovascular, respiratory, and galvanic skin response patterns.

1 AN ACT concerning professional regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Detection of Deception Examiners Act is amended by changing Section 3 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 430/3) (from Ch. 111, par. 2403)
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2012)
- Sec. 3. Every examiner $\underline{\text{must}}$ $\underline{\text{shall}}$ use an instrument which 8 permanently and simultaneously the 9 10 cardiovascular, respiratory, and galvanic skin response patterns as minimum standards and <u>must</u> shall base his 11 12 evaluation upon changes in such patterns. The Such an instrument may record additional physiological 13 patterns 14 pertinent to the detection of deception. The examiner may also 15 consider changes in such additional patterns in making his evaluations. An examiner <u>must</u> shall, upon written request of a 16 17 person examined, make known the results of such test to the person examined within 5 days of receipt of the written 18 19 request.
