1 AN ACT concerning vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing

 Section 18b-101 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/18b-101) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 18b-101)
- Sec. 18b-101. Definitions. Unless the context otherwise clearly requires, as used in this Chapter:
- 9 <u>"Air mile" means a nautical mile, which is equivalent to</u>
 10 <u>6,076 feet or 1,852 meters. Accordingly, 100 air miles are</u>
 11 <u>equivalent to 115.08 statute miles or 185.2 kilometers.</u>

"Commercial motor vehicle" means any self propelled or towed vehicle used on public highways in interstate and intrastate commerce to transport passengers or property when the vehicle has a gross vehicle weight, a gross vehicle weight rating, a gross combination weight, or a gross combination weight rating of 10,001 or more pounds; or the vehicle is used or designed to transport more than 15 passengers, including the driver; or the vehicle is designed to carry 15 or fewer passengers and is operated by a contract carrier transporting employees in the course of their employment on a highway of this State; or the vehicle is used or designed to transport between 9 and 15 passengers, including the driver, for direct compensation, if the vehicle is being operated beyond a radius of 75 air miles (86.3 statute miles or 138.9 kilometers) from the driver's normal work reporting location; or the vehicle is used in the transportation of hazardous materials in a quantity requiring placarding under the Illinois Hazardous Materials Transportation Act. This definition shall not include farm machinery, fertilizer spreaders, and other agricultural movement equipment described in Section 3-809 nor implements of husbandry as defined in Section 1-130;

"Direct compensation" means payment made to the motor

- 2 <u>carrier by the passengers or a person acting on behalf of the</u>
- 3 passengers for the transportation services provided, and not
- 4 <u>included in a total package charge or other assessment for</u>
- 5 <u>highway transportation services;</u>
- 6 "Officer" means Illinois State Police Officer;
- 7 "Person" means any natural person or individual,
- 8 governmental body, firm, association, partnership,
- 9 copartnership, joint venture, company, corporation, joint
- 10 stock company, trust, estate or any other legal entity or their
- 11 legal representative, agent or assigns.
