first appointed under this amendatory Act of 1984 shall serve 1 for a term of 6 years. After the expiration of the terms of the 2 3 office of the members first appointed to the State Board, their 4 respective successors shall hold office for a term of 6 years 5 and until their successors are qualified and seated. In the event of vacancies on the State Board in offices appointed by 6 the Governor occurring during a recess of the Senate, the 7 8 Governor shall have the power to make temporary appointments until the next meeting of the Senate, when the vacancy shall be 9 filled by nomination to be confirmed by the Senate. 10

Sec. 2-2. The members of the State Board shall be citizens 13 14 and residents of the State of Illinois and shall be selected as 15 far as may be practicable on the basis of their knowledge of, or interest and experience in, community colleges. No member of 16 17 the State Board shall be engaged in education as a profession 18 or hold current membership on a school board or board of 19 trustees of a public or non-public college, university or 20 technical institute or be employed by the State or federal 21 government.

This Section does not prohibit <u>a</u> the student member of the State Board from being employed by a public community college. (Source: P.A. 86-485.)
