1 AN ACT in relation to business transactions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business

 Practices Act is amended by changing Section 2 as follows:
- 6 (815 ILCS 505/2) (from Ch. 121 1/2, par. 262)
- 7 Sec. 2. <u>Unlawful practice; federal law.</u> Unfair methods of competition and unfair or deceptive acts or practices, 8 9 including but not limited to the use or employment of any 10 deception, fraud, false pretense, false promise, misrepresentation, or the concealment, suppression, 11 omission of any material fact, with intent that others rely 12 upon the concealment, suppression, or omission of such material 13 14 fact, or the use or employment of any practice described in 15 Section 2 of the "Uniform Deceptive Trade Practices Act", approved August 5, 1965, in the conduct of any trade or 16 17 commerce are hereby declared unlawful whether any person has in fact been misled, deceived, or damaged thereby. In construing 18 19 Section, consideration shall be given to interpretations of the Federal Trade Commission and the federal 20 courts relating to Section 5 (a) of the Federal Trade 21 22 Commission Act.
