20 ILCS 105/8.10 new

Amends the Illinois Act on the Aging. Requires the Department on Aging, in cooperation with the Department of Insurance, to promote the provision of employer-sponsored, long-term care insurance and sets forth the duties of the Department in doing so.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Act on the Aging is amended by adding Section 8.10 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 105/8.10 new)
- 7 Sec. 8.10. Promotion of long-term care insurance. Subject to appropriation, the Department, in cooperation with the 8 Department of Insurance, must promote, either directly or 9 through contract, the provision of employer-sponsored, 10 long-term care insurance. The Department must: encourage 11 private and public sector employers to make long-term care 12 insurance available to employees; provide interested employers 13 with information on the long-term care insurance product 14 15 offered to State employees; and provide technical assistance to employers in designing long-term care insurance products and 16 contacting companies offering long-term care insurance 17
