Amends the Criminal Code of 1961. Makes a technical change in a Section defining the offense of tattooing the body of a minor.

1 AN ACT in relation to criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by changing
- 5 Section 12-10 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/12-10) (from Ch. 38, par. 12-10)
- 7 Sec. 12-10. Tattooing Body of Minor.+ \underline{A} Any person, other
- 8 than a person licensed to practice medicine in all its
- 9 branches, who tattoos or offers to tattoo a person under the
- 10 age of 21 is guilty of a Class C misdemeanor.
- 11 As used in this Section, to "tattoo" means to insert
- 12 pigment under the surface of the skin of a human being, by
- 13 pricking with a needle or otherwise, so as to produce an
- indelible mark or figure visible through the skin.
