Amends the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963. Makes a technical change in a Section that permits the defendant to waive his or her right to be present during trial.

1 AN ACT in relation to criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 is amended by changing Section 115-8 as follows:
- 6 (725 ILCS 5/115-8) (from Ch. 38, par. 115-8)
- 7 Sec. 115-8. A defendant may waive his <u>or her</u> right to be
- 8 present during trial. However, upon motion of the State's
- 9 Attorney made prior to or during trial, the court shall order
- 10 the defendant to present himself in open court for the purpose
- of identification.
