1 AN ACT concerning labor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Child Labor Law is amended by changing
- 5 Section 4 as follows:
- 6 (820 ILCS 205/4) (from Ch. 48, par. 31.4)
- 7 Sec. 4. <u>Meal period.</u> No minor under sixteen (16) years of
- 8 age shall be employed, or permitted to work in any gainful
- 9 occupations mentioned in Section 1 of this Act for more than
- 10 five (5) hours continuously without an interval of at least
- 11 thirty (30) minutes for meal period, and no period of less than
- 12 thirty (30) minutes shall be deemed to interrupt a continuous
- period of work.
