SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

35 ILCS 171/3

Amends the Simplified Sales and Use Tax Administration Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning legislative findings.

1 AN ACT concerning taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Simplified Sales and Use Tax Administration
- 5 Act is amended by changing Section 3 as follows:
- 6 (35 ILCS 171/3)
- 7 Sec. 3. Legislative finding. The General Assembly finds that a simplified sales tax and use tax system will reduce and 8 over time eliminate the burden and cost for all vendors to 9 collect Illinois' this State's sales and use tax. The General 10 Assembly further finds that <u>Illinois</u> this State should 11 participate in multistate discussions to review or amend or 12 13 both review and amend the terms of the Agreement to simplify and modernize sales tax and use tax administration in order to 14 15 substantially reduce the burden of tax compliance for all sellers and for all types of commerce. 16
