Amends the Illinois Seed Law. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the labeling of coated agricultural seeds.

1 AN ACT concerning agriculture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Seed Law is amended by changing
- 5 Section 4.2a as follows:
- 6 (505 ILCS 110/4.2a) (from Ch. 5, par. 404.2a)
- 7 Sec. 4.2a. Agricultural seeds that are coated $\underline{\text{must}}$ $\underline{\text{shall}}$ be
- 8 labeled with:
- 9 (1) Percentage of pure seeds with coating material removed.
- 10 (2) Percentage of coating material shall be shown as a
- 11 separate item in close association with the percentage of inert
- 12 matter.
- 13 (3) In addition to the provisions of this Section, labeling
- of coated seed shall comply with the requirements of Section
- 15 4.2.
