Amends the Nursing Home Care Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning a notice of violation.

1 AN ACT concerning nursing home care.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Nursing Home Care Act is amended by changing Section 3-301 as follows:
- 6 (210 ILCS 45/3-301) (from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 4153-301)
- 7 Sec. 3-301. Notice of violation. If after receiving the report specified in subsection (c) of Section 3-212 the 8 9 Director or his designee determines that a facility is in violation of this Act or of any rule promulgated thereunder, he 10 shall serve a notice of violation upon the licensee within 10 11 days thereafter. Each notice of violation shall be prepared in 12 writing and shall specify the nature of the violation, and the 13 14 statutory provision or rule alleged to have been violated. The 15 notice shall inform the licensee of any action the Department may take under the Act, including the requirement of a facility 16 17 plan of correction under Section 3-303; placement of the facility on a list prepared under Section 3-304; assessment of 18 19 a penalty under Section 3-305; a conditional license under 20 Sections 3-311 through 3-317; or license suspension revocation under Section 3-119. The Director or his designee 21 22 shall also inform the licensee of rights to a hearing under Section 3-703. 23
