AN ACT in relation to property taxes.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Property Tax Code is amended by changing
Section 16-175 as follows:

6 (35 ILCS 200/16-175)

Sec. 16-175. Subpoenas. The Chairman of the Property Tax 7 Appeal Board or his or her designee may issue subpoenas that 8 which shall be served by any person lawfully authorized to 9 serve a subpoena under the laws of the State of Illinois. In 10 11 case of disobedience to a subpoena, the Board may petition any 12 circuit court of the State for an order requiring the attendance and testimony of witnesses. Witnesses attending any 13 14 hearing held by the Property Tax Appeal Board, pursuant to any 15 subpoena, shall be paid the same fees and mileage that are paid witnesses in the circuit courts of the State. 16
