Amends the Illinois Fertilizer Act of 1961. Makes a technical change concerning the Fertilizer Control Fund.

1 AN ACT concerning agriculture.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Fertilizer Act of 1961 is amended
- 5 by changing Section 6b as follows:
- 6 (505 ILCS 80/6b) (from Ch. 5, par. 55.6b)
- 7 Sec. 6b. Fertilizer Control Fund. The amount annually
- 8 deposited in the Fertilizer Control Fund shall be appropriated
- 9 for the operation of the Fertilizer Research and Education
- 10 Program.
- 11 These moneys shall be used for expenses consistent with
- 12 carrying out the purpose and intent of the program, which
- include council expenses, peer review, and contracts to persons
- 14 for research or education projects and costs associated with
- 15 general operating expenses, such as administrative support,
- 16 travel, commodities, and printing. The Department shall
- 17 receive 3% of the annual amount deposited in the Fertilizer
- 18 Control Fund.
