Amends the Animal Control Act. Makes technical changes in a Section concerning rabies inoculations.

1 AN ACT in relation to animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Animal Control Act is amended by changing Section 8 as follows:
- 6 (510 ILCS 5/8) (from Ch. 8, par. 358)
- 7 Sec. 8. Rabies inoculation. Every owner of a dog 4 months or more of age shall have each dog inoculated against rabies by 8 a licensed veterinarian. Every dog shall have a second rabies 9 vaccination within one year of the first. Terms of subsequent 10 vaccine administration and duration of immunity must be in 11 compliance with USDA licenses of vaccines used. Evidence of 12 such rabies inoculation shall be entered on a certificate the 13 14 form of which shall be approved by the Board and which shall be 15 signed by the licensed veterinarian administering the vaccine. Veterinarians who inoculate a dog shall procure from the County 16 17 Animal Control serially numbered tags, one to be issued with 18 each inoculation certificate. Only one dog shall be included on 19 each certificate. The veterinarian immunizing or microchipping 20 an animal shall provide the Administrator with a certificate of 21 immunization and microchip number. The Board shall cause a rabies inoculation tag to be issued, at a fee established by 22 23 the Board for each dog inoculated against rabies.
- Rabies vaccine for use on animals shall be sold or distributed only to licensed veterinarians. Such rabies vaccine shall be licensed by the United States Department of Agriculture.
