# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Consumer Installment Loan Act is amended bychanging Section 8 as follows:

6 (205 ILCS 670/8) (from Ch. 17, par. 5408)

Sec. 8. Annual license fee; expenses. Before the 15th day of each December, a licensee must pay to the Director, and the Department must receive, the annual license fee required by Section 2 for the next succeeding calendar year. The license shall expire on the first of January unless the license fee has been paid prior thereto.

In addition to <u>the</u> <del>such</del> license fee, the reasonable expense of any examination, investigation or custody by the Director under any provisions of this Act shall be borne by the licensee.

17 If a licensee fails to renew his or her license by the 31st 18 day of December, it shall automatically expire and the licensee 19 is not entitled to a hearing; however, the Director, in his or 20 her discretion, may reinstate an expired license upon payment 21 of the annual renewal fee and proof of good cause for failure 22 to renew.
