1 AN ACT in relation to civil procedure.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by changing Section 1-105 as follows:
- 6 (735 ILCS 5/1-105) (from Ch. 110, par. 1-105)
- 7 Sec. 1-105. Enforcement of $\underline{\text{Code}}$ $\underline{\text{Act}}$ and rules. The Supreme Court may provide by rule for the orderly and expeditious 8 administration and enforcement of this $\underline{\text{Code}}$ $\underline{\text{Act}}$ and of the 9 rules, including the striking of pleadings, the dismissal of 10 claims, the entry of defaults, the assessment of costs, the 11 assessment against an offending party of the reasonable 12 expenses, including attorney's fees, which any violation 13 causes another party to incur, or other action that may be 14 15 appropriate.
