110 ILCS 205/9.30 new

Amends the Board of Higher Education Act. Requires the Board to study privatization of student living at public universities and report to the General Assembly by January 1, 2006. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning education.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Board of Higher Education Act is amended by
adding Section 9.30 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 205/9.30 new)

7 Sec. 9.30. Privatize residential living; study. The Board, in cooperation with public universities in Illinois, shall 8 conduct a study on the privatization of residential living for 9 students. The purpose of the study is to seek alternative 10 methods to meet the demand for additional and upgraded housing 11 by using the efficiencies and creativity of the private sector 12 while maintaining control over design, operation, and quality. 13 The study shall address cost-efficiency, private developer 14 15 opportunities, liability issues, capital investments, financial impact, financing scenarios, operating options, 16 student life, and liability issues. The Board shall report its 17 findings and recommendations to the General Assembly by January 18 19 1, 2006.

20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 21 becoming law.
