Amends the School Code. Replaces provisions requiring teachers to teach students honesty, kindness, justice, discipline, respect for others, and moral courage with provisions requiring teachers to teach students respect, responsibility, fairness, caring, trustworthiness, and citizenship. Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
27-12 as follows:

(105 ILCS 5/27-12) (from Ch. 122, par. 27-12) 6 Sec. 27-12. Character education. Honesty, kindness, 7 justice and moral courage. Every public school teacher shall 8 teach students respect, responsibility, fairness, caring, 9 trustworthiness, and citizenship in order to raise the pupils 10 honesty, kindness, justice, discipline, respect for others, 11 and moral courage for the purpose of lessening crime and 12 raising the standard of good character citizenship. 13 (Source: P.A. 90-620, eff. 7-10-98.) 14

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
