## 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections
10-20.39 and 34-18.30 as follows:

Sec. 10-20.39. Highly qualified teachers; No Child Left 7 Behind Act funds. If a school district has an overall shortage 8 of highly qualified teachers, as defined by the federal No 9 Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (Public Law 107-110), or a 10 shortage of highly qualified teachers in the subject area of 11 mathematics, science, reading, or special education, then the 12 school board must spend at least 40% of the money it receives 13 14 from Title 2 grants under the Act on professional development 15 for teachers (in a specific subject area if applicable) until there is no longer a shortage of highly gualified teachers (in 16 a specific subject area if applicable). As the number of highly 17 qualified teachers in the district increases, however, the 18 19 school board may spend any surplus of the minimum 40% of funds dedicated to addressing the highly qualified teacher shortage 20 in any manner the school board deems appropriate. 21

Sec. 34-18.30. Highly qualified teachers; No Child Left 23 Behind Act funds. If a school district has an overall shortage 24 25 of highly qualified teachers, as defined by the federal No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (Public Law 107-110), or a 26 27 shortage of highly qualified teachers in the subject area of mathematics, science, reading, or special education, then the 28 29 board must spend at least 40% of the money it receives from Title 2 grants under the Act on professional development for 30 teachers (in a specific subject area if applicable) until there 31

is no longer a shortage of highly qualified teachers (in a specific subject area if applicable). As the number of highly qualified teachers in the district increases, however, the school board may spend any surplus of the minimum 40% of funds dedicated to addressing the highly qualified teacher shortage in any manner the school board deems appropriate.
