Makes appropriations and reappropriations to Northern Illinois University for various purposes, including for ordinary and contingent expenses. Effective July 1, 2004.

1 AN ACT making appropriations and reappropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4	Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof
5	as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and
6	purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the General
7	Revenue Fund to the Board of Trustees of Northern Illinois
8	University to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of
9	the University, including payment or reimbursement to the
10	University for personal services and related costs, incurred
11	during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005:
12	For Personal Services, including payment
13	to the University for personal service
14	and related costs incurred during the
15	fiscal year\$86,202,400
16	For Contractual Services\$6,456,100
17	For Travel\$159,500
18	For Commodities\$1,971,400
19	For Equipment and Library Books\$1,581,500
20	For Operations of Auto Equipment\$138,500
21	For Telecommunications Services\$796,900
22	For Repair, Maintenance, and Other Capital
23	Improvements\$1,560,700
24	For Awards and Grants and Matching Funds\$185,700
25	For State Contributions to Social

29	Section 10. The sum of \$532,748, or so much thereof as
30	may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of
31	business on June 30, 2004, from a reappropriation heretofore

- 1 made for that purpose in Article 4, Section 40 of Public Act
- 2 93-587, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund
- 3 to the Board of Trustees of Northern Illinois University for
- 4 technology infrastructure improvements at Northern Illinois
- 5 University. No contract shall be entered into or obligation
- 6 incurred for any expenditures from the reappropriation made
- 7 in this Section until after the purposes and amounts have
- 8 been approved in writing by the Governor.
- 9 Section 15. The sum of \$43,366, or so much thereof as
- 10 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of
- 11 business on June 30, 2004, from a reappropriation heretofore
- made for that purpose in Article 4, Section 45 of Public Act
- 93-587, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund
- 14 to the Board of Trustees of Northern Illinois University for
- 15 purchasing Engineering Building equipment.
- Section 20. The sum of \$10,075, or so much thereof as
- may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and
- 18 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of Northern
- 19 Illinois University for scholarship grant awards, in
- 20 accordance with Public Act 91-83.
- 21 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 22 2004.
