SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Department of Veterans' Affairs for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, as follows:

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1 AN ACT making appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

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ARTICLE 1

Section 1C. The sum of \$844,900, or so much thereof as 15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 16 Fund to the Department of Veterans' Affairs for the payment 17 of scholarships to students who are dependents of Illinois 18 resident military personnel declared to be prisoners of war, 19 missing in action, killed or permanently disabled, as 20 provided by law. 21

Section 1D. The sum of \$350,000, or so much thereof as 22 23 may be necessary, is appropriated from the World War II 24 Illinois Veterans' Memorial Fund to the Department of Veterans' Affairs for grants associated with the construction 25 and maintenance of an Illinois World War II Memorial. 26
