# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

17	Justice Information Authority for awards and grants to state
18	agencies and units of local government, including operational
19	expenses of the Authority in support of the Juvenile
20	Accountability Incentive Block Grant program:
