24 WHEREAS, He was a charter member of the Grant Park Lions 25 Club, serving as president twice; he was a lifelong member of 26 the Kankakee County Historical Society and member of the 20th 27 Century Club; and

28 WHEREAS, Mr. Lemon was the recipient of the "Harold 29 Award" for his outstanding work to further the Pledge for 30 Life program; in addition, the Kankakee County Administrators 31 Association established the Alan Lemon Award in his honor,
