2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of 3 Representatives were saddened to learn of the death of Alghia

5 WHEREAS, Alghia Griffin, Jr. was born in Vicksburg, 6 Mississippi on July 22, 1931; he was the third child born to 7 Rev. Alghia Griffin, Sr. and Maria Bozeman; his primary and 8 elementary school years were completed at Cherry Street School 9 and Bowman High school, in Vicksburg; and

WHEREAS, He was gifted with an unusual musical ability that can be traced back in his family tree to the 1800s; he was able to play a wide range of instruments, including every wind and string instrument, the complete percussion section, organ, and piano; he was presented the highest outstanding music award for all four years of high school; he was then employed by his uncle, the first black man to organize a band in the Vicksburg area; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Griffin was called to the Ministry while a member of Bethel A.M.E. Church in Vicksburg, the place for all of his Christian training from childhood to manhood; and

WHEREAS, He served his country with dignity and pride as Spec. 4th Class Radio Operator for four years in the U.S. Army, during the Korean War; he then relocated to Chicago in 1954; and

25 WHEREAS, Mr. Griffin was employed by Jefferson Electric, 26 the Chicago Transit Authority, the Village of Maywood, and the 27 Federal Government for many years; and

WHEREAS, The passing of Alghia (June) Griffin, Jr. will be deeply felt by many, especially his wife, Diana Griffin; his
